The Graduate Certificate in Teaching Religious Education (GCTRE) prepares graduates to teach religious education. It provides graduates with knowledge of the disciplines, principles, practices, and traditions that form the basis for religious education. Entry requirements

- Successful completion of an undergraduate degree, or an approved equivalent
- A qualification recognised for teacher accreditation in Australia.

Course structure

4 units (18 points each) comprised of:

- BS8610Z Introduction to the Bible for Teachers
- CT8620Z Introduction to Theology for Teachers
- DT8630Z Introduction to Moral Theology for Teachers
- DR8640Z Introduction to Religious Education for Teachers

This course is offered part-time, I unit per semester over 2 years. Each unit has four, 4-hour online Saturday mornings each semester.

Accreditation and Sponsorship

This is a recognised course for teacher accreditation and sponsored study in all Victorian dioceses. In other dioceses, teachers should check with their education office.
