This Country Dioceses Leadership Program (CDLP) enables middle leaders from across three country dioceses (Ballarat, Sandhurst & Wagga Wagga) to engage in a residential 7-day professional development program with a significant focus on the skills, knowledge and capabilities for effective middle leadership within a Catholic context.

The program provides opportunities for participants to identify their effective leadership practice and apply this within their own school context through a spaced learning model, and a coaching program.
