

Catholic Education Week 6th - 12th September 2020 Listen to what the Spirit is saying in the Virtual Classroom

BACKGROUND FOR TEACHERS

Recognizing the central role that the Plenary Council will play in the life of the Australian Church in 2021 and beyond, the theme for Catholic Education Week 2020 is *Listen to what the Spirit is saying*. This theme focuses on listening and discernment (making choices) which is borne from rich dialogue. Pope Francis defines discernment as more than intelligence or common sense: 'It is a gift which we must implore. If we ask with confidence that the Holy Spirit grant us this gift, and then seek to develop it through prayer, reflection, reading and good counsel, then surely we will grow in this spiritual endowment.'

REMINDERS FOR TEACHERS:

Be aware of Covid restrictions when handling symbols, candle, bible. Remind children participating at school, to wash their hands before and after the prayer service — especially if they are readers who share a copy of the service. Ensure they are sitting with space between them.

Due to COVID restrictions – students/teachers at school are **not** permitted to sing along with the chosen gathering and/or final hymn.

Those students who are attending school, may wish to prepare a PowerPoint for the Litany.

THE INTRODUCTORY RITES

Introduction/Welcome:

Sound prayer chime/prayer bells /singing bowl/rain stick to call those present to stillness and silence. Or an appropriate gathering song of your choice could be played to gather all to this stillness and silence.

Due to COVID restrictions – students/teachers at school are not permitted to sing along with the chosen hymn.

Greeting: Welcome to our prayer today... (Create own words of greeting to your

community)

LEADER: Let us pray....

God, since the beginning, you have walked with humankind, totally concerned for our welfare, tenderly watching lest we stumble and fall. You reach out to help us in troubled times, you make our paths straight with your mercy and create wide roads so that we can walk together towards you. You have given us the opportunity of education in our Catholic schools so

that we can understand your love and bring this to the world. Strengthen us for our journey at this time and for the future.

Your Holy Spirit has breathed new life and filled the earth with many good gifts. Fill us with the fire of your great love so that we may listen to what the

Spirit is saying.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

ALL: Amen

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD God Speaks - We Listen

(Choose only one of these readings.

If students are chosen to read, ensure that they are able to PROCLAIM the Readings – ie. that they are well prepared so that they do not stumble over the words of the Reading.)

Readings:

Isaiah 61:1-2

The spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me; he has sent me to bring good news to the oppressed, to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and release to the prisoners; to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn.

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the discernment of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. All these are activated by one and the same Spirit, who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses.
